**MOUNTAIN BIKE RACING IN NORTH AMERICA**

For those who follow the sport of mountain biking and world of enduro racing, the Pacific Northwest is becoming the hub for this particular genre. In it's second year as the state-wide Oregon Super D Series, the 2011 sports property has doubled last year's sponsorship support and has also added a fourth event in Bend. Santa Cruz Bicycles is the title sponsor, which truly exemplifies that they are fully diverged into the All-Mountain arena; that has become the fastest growing category in mountain biking. The Oakridge Super D race course is "Epic" ride with over 13 miles of beautiful single track through old giant forest and astonishing views. It's fast...reaching speeds over 40mph it will test your bike handling skills and nerve. And, with short climbs scattered along the way it will test your endurance and fitness. It descends almost 5,000 vertical feet to finish at a historic red covered bridge and a perfect venue to host Race #3 of the Oregon Super D Series. The Super D season will conclude in early September at Sandy Ridge. The Oregon Super D Series is already doubling last year's total participant numbers and creating more fully-functional and entertaining mountain bike festivals for the entire family to enjoy.
